Great leaders have strong personal leadership skills

- These skills are based on character and integrity.

Great leaders have strong team building skills

- They are able to build effective partnerships and alliances within their own ministry and other ministries around the world.
- They are able to share, without feeling threatened, their leadership influence, impact and final results.
- They are able to recruit, teach, train, deploy and coach quality team players, team leaders and leaders of leaders.

Great leaders have strong strategic planning skills

- They possess a "Sons of Issachar" mentality. They understand the times and know what to do. They prepare for a future that is unknown and plan for the future as far as they can see and know the difference.
- They understand the impact of having a relevant worldview and understand the global landscape. They are able to balance today's ministry challenges while seizing tomorrow's opportunities.
